(WAMA - 2023 – 206109)

Exemption for jet karts from compliance with various provisions of the Navigable Waters Regulations 1958

I, **Mark Briant**, acting Director Waterways Safety Management, Department of Transport and delegate of the Chief Executive Officer, acting pursuant to the power in section 115A of the *Western Australian Marine Act 1982*, exempt jet karts from compliance with:

- regulations 51D, 52, 52A, and 52C of the *Navigable Waters Regulations 1958* (the *Regulations*); and
- subregulation 52B(1) of the *Regulations* when operating within 400m of any shore.

This exemption is subject to the following conditions:

1. the driver of a jet kart wears an appropriate lifejacket, as defined in regulation 50B of the *Regulations*; and
2. the jet kart carries a means of bailing out water.

The term 'jet kart' means a personal watercraft, modified temporarily or permanently so as to be operated by a person within it rather than on it.

This instrument revokes WAMA – 2022 – 204993 and is valid until 1 August 2025 unless revoked sooner.
