## Exemption for jet karts from compliance with various provisions of the Navigable Waters Regulations 1958

I, Mark Briant, acting Director Waterways Safety Management, Department of Transport and delegate of the Chief Executive Officer, acting pursuant to the power in section 115A of the Western Australian Marine Act 1982, exempt jet karts from compliance with:

- regulations 51D, 52, 52A, and 52C of the *Navigable Waters Regulations* 1958 (the *Regulations*); and
- subregulation 52B(1) of the Regulations when operating within 400m of any shore.

This exemption is subject to the following conditions:

- 1. the driver of a jet kart wears an appropriate lifejacket, as defined in regulation 50B of the *Regulations*; and
- 2. the jet kart carries a means of bailing out water.

The term 'jet kart' means a personal watercraft, modified temporarily or permanently so as to be operated by a person within it rather than on it.

This instrument revokes WAMA – 2022 – 204993 and is valid until 1 August 2025 unless revoked sooner.
