Please note that the Guideline Rates:

- Are based on standard, tray-top vehicles.
- Are based on fuel consumption data released by Australian Trucking Association.
- Are based on fuel data taken from the Fuel Watch website and sites chosen by the Road Freight Transport Industry Council (RFTIC) from 1 September 2024 to 30 September 2025.
- Do not set a minimum or maximum rate.
- Provide general guidance.
- May be considered by the Road Freight Transport Industry Tribunal when determining whether an owner driver contract is unfair, and a hirer has acted unconscionably.
- Metropolitan rates might also be applicable for some operations in regional areas.
- Table A rates are based on new vehicles; Table B rates are based on vehicles 5 years old.
- Owner-drivers and hirers need to consider their individual circumstances in deciding a rate that is appropriate for a particular freight task. The Owner-Drivers Cost Calculator, available on the Department of Transport and Major Infrastructure website at https://www.transport.wa.gov.au/supply-chains/freight/ownerdrivers, can assist with cost and rate calculations.
- "Prime mover + 1, 2 or 3 trailers" refers to trailers owned or leased by the ownerdriver.
- 2 axles => single steer, single drive; 3 axles => single steer, bogie drive.

The above rates have been approved by the Road Freight Transport Industry Council.
