## 2015-2016 Awarded Projects

# Perth Bicycle Network Grants

11 local governments, 5 primary schools and 1 senior high school have been successful recipients of the Department of Transport grants program in 2015-2016.

19 projects to be delivered with \$1.37m committed in 2015-16 and additional \$0.99m committed in 2016-17 for larger scoped projects

- 2 bicycle plans: \$74,750
- 1 bicycle boulevard design: \$40,000
- 2 protected bicycle lanes: \$160,500
- 6 shared paths: \$2,030,385 (\$1,040,225 in 2015-16)
- 2 end of trip facilities: \$8,500
- 6 connecting schools facilities: \$47,040
