2017-18 Awarded Projects

Perth Bicycle Network Grants

19 local governments and 3 primary schools have been successful recipients of the Department of Transport's Perth Bicycle Network Grants program in 2017-18.

The 25 projects to be delivered with \$1.96 million committed over two years include:

- One pre-committed bike boulevard;
- Three pre-committed shared paths;
- Five pre-committed bike plans;
- One intersection upgrade;
- Three shared paths;
- Four connecting schools facilities; and
- Nine design projects.
