



WA Bicycle Network Grants Program 2023-24 and 2024-25 Awarded Projects

This document details projects from both metropolitan and regional areas of Western Australia that successfully applied for funding through the Western Australian Bicycle Network (WABN) Grants Program in 2022 for projects to be delivered in 2023-24 and/or 2024-25.

Grants are staged across multiple years, with some projects and initiatives already committed through the previous grant round. In this grant round, 37 local governments have been successful recipients of \$9.6 million to deliver 47 new projects. Combined with already committed projects and related initiatives, this brings the total WABN Grant Program commitment to \$12.9 million, which includes the delivery of 63 projects and other related initiatives over 2023-24 and 2024-25.

* Connecting Schools Grant program fully funds bike education, place making initiatives and bike related infrastructure for eligible schools taking part in the Your Move Schools program.

Active Travel Officer Grant program provides seed funding for six local governments to employ a fulltime Active Travel Officer position for three years commencing July 2023.

2023-24 and 2024-25 Awarded Projects

Perth Bicycle Network Grants

Eleven local governments have been successful recipients of Perth Bicycle Network (PBN) grant funding through the 2022 WABN Grants Program intake for projects to be delivered in 2023-24 and/or 2024-25.

The 13 new projects to be funded with \$5.2 million committed over two years include a mix of planning, concept, design and construction scopes:

- One (1) local bicycle plan;
- Six (6) shared or separated paths;
- Five (5) safe active streets; and
- One (1) protected bike lane.

Combined with already committed projects and related initiatives, this brings the total PBN Program commitment to approximately \$6.2 million to deliver 18 projects and two related initiatives over 2023-24 and 2024-25.

Regional Bicycle Network Grants

Twenty-six local governments have been successful recipients of Regional Bicycle Network (RBN) grant funding through the 2022 WABN Grants Program intake for projects to be delivered in 2023-24 and/or 2024-25.

The 34 new projects to be funded with \$4.4 million committed over two years include a mix of planning, concept, design and construction scopes:

- Two (2) local bicycle plans; and
- Thirty-two (32) shared or separated paths.

Combined with already committed projects and related initiatives, this brings the total RBN Program commitment to approximately \$6.8 million to deliver 45 projects and two related initiatives over 2023-24 and 2024-25.
