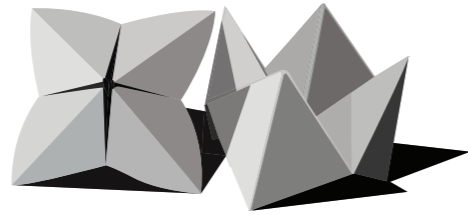




Chatterbox

How to make:

1. Print the template on an A3 piece of paper.
2. Cut along the dashed line so that you have a square.
3. Fold the paper in half up and down, then unfold it and fold in half diagonally. Unfold it.
4. Turn the chatterbox over so that the blank back of the paper is facing you.
5. Take each corner and fold it neatly into the centre. You should end up with a diamond.
6. Turn the chatterbox over again so that the words/pictures are facing you.
7. Again, take each corner and fold it neatly into the centre. You should end up with a smaller diamond this time.
8. Fold it in half so that you have a rectangle.
9. Put your thumbs and forefingers under each of the squares to form pockets on each side and work the chatterbox open.



How to play:

1. Hold the chatterbox closed.
2. Ask someone to choose a letter, either B, I, K or E.
3. Open and close the chatterbox as many times as what the number above the selected letter is. For example, if someone chooses the letter K, open and close the chatterbox three times.
4. Ask the person to choose a bike related word from the centre of the chatterbox.
5. Open and close the chatterbox by spelling out the word (the number of letters is written near the word).
6. Ask them again to choose one of the bike related words displayed.
7. Open it to reveal the hidden message inside!
