

## ROAD TRAFFIC (VEHICLES) REGULATIONS 2014

## RTVR-2022-205471

## APPROVAL FOR CERTAIN VEHICLE TYPES TO ACCESS MONTHLY VEHICLE LICENCE RENEWAL SCHEME

I, Linley Crackel, Executive Director, Driver and Vehicle Services, Department of Transport (DoT) and delegate of the CEO of DoT, pursuant to regulation 31A(4) of the *Road Traffic (Vehicles) Regulations 2014* (the Regulations), approve **light vehicles** as a type of vehicle for the purposes of regulation 31A(2)(g) subject to the condition that the vehicle is NOT:

- a) subject to a licence charge reduction under regulation 72, exemption under Part 2, Division 7, Subdivision 4 (excluding an exemption granted under regulation 71), or concession under Part 2, Division 7, Subdivision 5 of the Regulations (excluding a concession granted under regulation 83);
- b) licenced by a person who has 3 or more vehicle licences that have been varied under regulation 32 so that they all expire on the same day;
- c) required to be inspected prior to a vehicle licence renewal in accordance with the *Road Traffic (Vehicle) Inspection Order 2019* made pursuant to section 19 of the Act;
- d) subject to a cancelled or suspended licence under section 9 of the Act;
- e) owned by a person who has applied for a vehicle transfer for that vehicle but has not paid the amount specified by section 5(1)(b) of the Act;
- f) an overseas vehicle, temporarily in Australia, licensed under Part 3 of the Act;
- g) recorded on the Written-Off Vehicle Register as required by regulation 156 of the Regulations;
- h) recorded on the vehicle licence register as stolen;
- i) subject to a Class B or C vehicle licence under regulation 35 and 36 of the Regulations respectively;
- j) subject to a licence suspension order made under section 19 or 43 of the *Fines, Penalties* and *Infringement Notices Enforcement Act 1994*;
- k) required to be examined prior to renewal pursuant to regulation 24(2) of the Regulations;
- I) subject to a defect notice under section 71 of the Act;
- m) a caravan, tow truck, moped, motorised wheelchair, trailer (including but not limited to converter dolly, dog-trailer, pig-trailer, semi-trailer, pole type trailer), or mobile crane; nor
- n) a 'tractor plant'; defined as a motor vehicle that is designed for use primarily in industry (whether in the public or private sector) and to be driven or controlled by a person carried in or on the vehicle; and is not designed for use primarily for the carriage of passengers or goods on roads or for hauling a semi-trailer.

Terms in this instrument that are defined in the Act have the same meaning as in the Act.
