

## YOUR OPTIONS

Pay this infringement. Pay in full before the due date to avoid further penalties or prosecution. If you do not pay, make a payment instalment arrangement or elect court by the due date, the infringement will be referred to the Fines Enforcement Registry under the Fines, Penalties and Infringement Notices Enforcement Act 1994.

Unable to pay by the due date? You can before the due date request a payment extension or you may enter a direct debit payment instalment arrangement. Sign in to DoTDirect or call Infringement Services on (08) 9320 4444.

Request a review. You may request a review by contacting Infringement Services on (09) 9320 4444 or emailing infringementservices@transport.wa.gov.au if you were not the driver at the time of the alleged offence.

Elect to have the matter determined by a Court. Complete the Court Election request by signing in to DoTDirect or returning the form provided to Infringement Services before the due date.

## **OTHER INFORMATION**

Payment will not be regarded as an admission of liability for any civil claim, action or proceeding, but constitutes a conviction for the purposes of the Road Traffic (Authorisation to Drive) Act 2008 section 35(4)(b)(v), and the Road Traffic (Vehicles) Act 2012 section 126(6) and 128(4).

For a provisional licence driver, payment for Road Traffic Act 1974 section 54, 55, 62 and 64AA, offences constitute a conviction, licence cancellation and three months disqualification from driving.

**Warnings**: Provision of false or misleading information is an offence with significant penalties including \$18,000 or 18 months imprisonment.

**Privacy**: The information you supply on this form may be disclosed to other government agencies where provided for in legislation. The Chief Executive Officer of the Department of Transport also releases aggregated statistical information to third parties.
