



Lancelin Maritime Facility



Lancelin is a fishing town 127 kilometres north of Perth situated in the Wheatbelt region. The town is well known as a holiday destination and is the home port for a large number of crayfishing vessels. It is also known for its superb windsurfing conditions, which attracts many of the sport's enthusiasts.

Lancelin is a popular destination for all varieties of water sports. Snorkellers and divers can explore the 14 dive wrecks and numerous reefs. There are also many great fishing spots and sea lions and dolphins can often be spotted in the waters nearby.

The facility has a service jetty and fuelling facilities for commercial fishing vessels.

Boating facility fees

T shaped jetty

Services	Single and three-phase power, water, lighting and Diesel fuel. A free waste oil and filter disposal facility is available at the Whitesands Mechanical Workshop located at corner of Walker Ave and King Street.

Fuelling facilities

Fuel is available from each end of the Service jetty. This service is provided by both Bailey's Marine Fuels and Fuel Distributors WA.

Other facilities and services

Public toilets

There are no public toilets or showers available.

Public car park

There is a public car park located near the jetty abutment.

Dredging

Note that the beach behind the jetty is accreting and the depth at the jetty is subject to seasonal maintenance dredging.

Marine rescue

All volunteer marine rescue groups monitor radio listening watches on marine radio 27.88 MHz and VHF Channel 16. Most groups also monitor other frequencies such as 27.90 MHz, 27.91 MHz and VHF channels 72 and 73, as well as their own channels.

Don't hesitate to call any volunteer marine rescue group on your marine radio.

Remember to log on before heading out and log off when you return with your local volunteer marine rescue group, for full radio procedure refer to Boat rules at a glance.
