



Leeman Maritime Facility



Leeman is a coastal town situated 295 kilometres from Perth, on the Batavia Coast in the Mid West region. Commercial fishing, including lobster fishing, is a major industry in the town. Coastal attractions include swimming, surfing, wind surfing and fishing. The blue waters and many islands also make it a great diving destination.

The maritime facility consists of one timber service jetty, fuelling facilities and boat ramps, as well as public toilets and car park. It is situated in open waters, with an offshore reef providing limited protection.

Boating facility fees

Boating facilities

Service jetty

Description	The "L" shaped service jetty consists of steel tubular piles, with timber half caps, stringers and deck.
Lengths	Head dimensions: 20 metres x 6.5 metres. Approach neck length: 96 metres.
Services	Single, three phase power, water and fuel.

Fueling facilities

Fuel is available from the service jetty. The service is provided by Baileys Marine Fuels for Baileys Marine customer cardholders only.

Boat ramp

There are two boat ramps in Leeman, both operated by the Shire of Coorow.

One of the ramps, a single lane gravel ramp, is located in close proximity to the service jetty.

The other boat ramp is also a single lane gravel ramp, but has a catwalk. It is located at the north end of the town, near the Leeman Sea Search and Rescue building.

Note: Recreational boat users and all vessels unfamiliar with local conditions should contact the local Sea Search and Rescue group before any boating trip.

Other facilities and services

Public toilets

There are public toilets located near the boat ramp, in close proximity to the service jetty.

Public car park

There is a public sealed car park located near the jetty abutment.

Marine rescue

All volunteer marine rescue groups monitor radio listening watches on marine radio 27.88 MHz and VHF Channel 16. Most groups also monitor other frequencies such as 27.90 MHz, 27.91 MHz and VHF channels 72 and 73, as well as their own channels.

Don't hesitate to call any volunteer marine rescue group on your marine radio.

Remember to log on before heading out and log off when you return with your local volunteer marine rescue group, for full radio procedure refer to Boat rules at a glance.
