Phase two of the Movement and Place project is underway. Quarter one 2021 has been an exciting period for the project with the draft Framework being put through its paces with desktop testing.

Participants from the Transport Portfolio and Department of Planning Lands and Heritage, joined representatives from the WA Local Government Association (WALGA), the City of Canning, the City of South Perth and the Town of Victoria Park to test the draft Framework on hypothetical scenarios in the respective Local Government areas.

The test scenarios highlighted a need to:

- refine the criteria for classifying a road or street using the matrix (Figure 1);
- provide a list of data and information to inform decision makers using the draft Framework; and
- provide clearer guidance on who uses a road or street, and how their needs may change in the future depending on a predominantly movement or place role.
