THE BIG PICTURE

Currently, about 2 million people call Perth and Peel home. While it took 180 years to reach this population, current trends predict that more than 3.5 million people will live in Perth and Peel by 2050.

Creating great places for Western Australians to live, work and play is at the heart of the State Government's Perth and Peel @ 3.5 million framework. The strategic suite of planning and infrastructure documents outlines how we will accommodate a substantially increased population and maintain our valued lifestyle.

Increased density will require us to make better use of resources and infrastructure, including our roads and streets. We will need to do more than just provide for transport (movement). We must also understand the roles of our roads as destinations people travel to and spend time (place).
