**Assessment and Liaison Equipment**  
Wyndham, Broome, Karratha, Carnarvon  
Geraldton, Fremantle, Albany, Esperance  
Coverage area: within 300km of stockpile location  
Mobilisation method: Drive/vessel any coastal location within 300km of stockpile location

**Field Response Equipment – North West**  
Karratha  
Coverage Area: Kimberly, Pilbara and Mid-West-Gascoyne districts  
Mobilisation Method: Drive/tow any coastal location north of Carnarvon and west of Broome  
Mobilisation Method: Fly/freight any coastal location south of Carnarvon and east of Broome

**Incident Management Equipment**  
Fremantle  
Coverage Area: Whole State  
Mobilisation Method: Drive/tow any coastal location south of Geraldton and west of Esperance  
Mobilisation Method: Fly/freight any coastal location north of Geraldton and east of Esperance

**Field Response Equipment – South West**  
Fremantle  
Coverage Area: Mid-West-Gascoyne, Wheatbelt, Metropolitan, South-West, Great Southern and Goldfields-Esperance districts  
Mobilisation Method: Drive/tow any coastal location south of Geraldton and west of Esperance  
Mobilisation Method: Fly/freight any coastal location north of Geraldton and east of Esperance

**Wildlife Response Equipment**  
Fremantle  
Coverage Area: Whole State  
Mobilisation Method: Drive/tow Field Equipment any coastal location south of Geraldton and west of Esperance  
Mobilisation Method: Freight Field Equipment any coastal location north of Geraldton and east of Esperance and freight primary care facilities any coastal location
