This form may be used if you wish to apply for the recognition of learner driver competencies completed in another Australian jurisdiction, New Zealand (NZ) or the Indian Ocean Territories (IOT).

It is an offence under the *Road Traffic (Administration) Act 2008* to obtain, or attempt to obtain, a driver's licence through a false statement, misrepresentation or other dishonest means. Maximum penalty is \$1,600.

You must apply for the recognition of competencies at the time you apply for a WA driver's licence and you must hold, have held, or provide evidence of:

- a New Zealand Class 1 (car) or Class 6 (motorcycle) learner licence;
- an IOT C class (car) or R-E class (motorcycle) learner's permit/licence; or
- a successful learner driver competency for the relevant class from an interstate road transport authority.

If the information given by you in this application is incomplete or the Department of Transport (DoT) is not able to verify the learner driver competency completed, your learner driver competencies will NOT be recognised and you will be required to undertake them again.
