Exemption from compliance with certain speed limits for Bunbury Rowing Club's safety vessels

- I, **Graeme Meinema**, Director Waterways Safety Management, Department of Transport and Major Infrastructure and delegate of the Chief Executive Officer, acting pursuant to the power in section 115A of the *Western Australian Marine Act 1982* (the Act), hereby exempt a person who is navigating a Bunbury Rowing Club vessel from the application of:
 - 1. Regulations 48(a)(ii), 48(c), 48(d)(i), 48(d)(iv) and 48(e) of the *Navigable Waters Regulations* 1958; and
 - 2. The following orders made under section 67 of the Act:
 - (a) MX407 in the *Government Gazette* as published on 27 February 2007 limiting speed for Leschenault Inlet; and
 - (b) MA403 in the *Government Gazette* as published on 20 December 2013 limiting speed for the Collie River.

The exemption of a person navigating is subject to the following conditions:

- 1. The vessel only exceeds the applicable speed limit:
 - (a) if the person assesses that it is appropriate to do so; and
 - (b) to the extent that is reasonably necessary for the person to effectively undertake Club safety or Club coaching, umpiring or training activities,
- 2. The vessel is at least 15m from any vessel underway that is not associated with the activities:
- 3. The vessel does not exceed the applicable speed limit by more than 12 knots;
- 4. The vessel displays the word 'Safety' in letters at least 200mm high and 20mm thick, either on both sides of the hull, or on a white flag in red writing positioned on the vessel so that it is visible to other vessels:
- 5. The vessel has suitable and operational navigational lights fitted and these shine after sunset and before sunrise and at other times of reduced visibility;
- 6. The vessel has a suitable and operational orange 360° flashing light fitted and this flashes after sunset and before sunrise and at other times of reduced visibility;
- 7. The person holds, as a minimum, a Recreational Skipper's Ticket;
- 8. The person complies with all applicable aspects of the *Bunbury Rowing Club Safety Management Plan 2025*;
- 9. The person complies with the *Prevention of Collisions in State Waters Regulations 1983* including but not limited to:
 - (a) Rule 5 (Look-out);
 - (b) Rule 6 (Safe Speed);
 - (c) Rule 7 (Risk of Collision);
 - (d) Rule 22 (Visibility of Lights); and
 - (e) Rule 23 (Power Driven Vessel Underway).

This instrument is valid from when it is signed until 1 August 2027 unless revoked sooner.
