Increased security of licence cards

In July 2014 the Department of Transport's (DoT) Driver and Vehicle Services (DVS) business unit enhanced the design and security features of all its licence cards as part of its commitment to secure identities and maintaining international identification best-practice standards.

The new cards feature a revised design and enhanced security features to protect the community against identify theft. These security features are equal to current international best-practice standards, to make forgery far more difficult and act as a deterrent against fraudulent activity and identity crime. The new licence cards have a range of overt and also covert security features, which are withheld to protect their integrity.






